## CLINICAL TRIALS WITH ANIMALS INVOLVING FOREVER LIVING PRODUCTS' ALOE VERA

### 1. Cochrane and Knottenbelt - University of Liverpool

Study: Effects of FLP Aloe Vera Gel (drink) on Skin in Horses

Findings: Replication of skin cells 2 to 3 times faster than with conventional treatments.

### 2. C. Symonds Chief Vet PDSA Liverpool

Study: Comparison of FLP Gelly (Topical Aloe Vera) with traditional treatment in dogs and cats

Findings: With FLP Aloe Vera Gelly there was no excess granulation, faster healing times and earlier dressing removal times. Also there was a 57% financial saving using FLP Aloe Vera Gelly when compared to traditional treatments.

### 3. H. Kaye

Study: Effects of feeding FLP Aloe Vera Gel drink on Horse's hooves

Findings: Hoof growth increased by 42% and hoof quality increased, when FLP Aloe Vera was given internally.

### 4. Dr B McGorum

Study: Equine grass sickness management in horses using FLP Aloe Vera Gel drink.

Findings: Commonly horses die from Equine grass sickness. In this study no horses died after being given up to 4 litres of FLP Aloe Vera Gel daily.

### 5. Gerald Durrell Zoo Jersey

Study: The effects of FLP Aloe Vera Gel drink on monkeys with a condition similar to IBS in humans.

Findings: Ongoing

### 6. R Jackson Vet Dorset

Effects of FLP Aloe Vera Gel drink on Pheasants with a deadly protozoan parasite.

Findings: Ongoing

### 7. Unknown

Various studies using FLP Aloe Vera Gel drink with Chickens, Turkeys and pigs.

Findings: Up to 50% decrease in mortality and up to 5% increase in growth.

### 8. Professor W R Allen Cambridge University

Study on behalf of The Equine Breeder's Association: Effects of flushing out the uterus with FLP Aloe Vera Vet Spray.

Findings: Uterus afterwards was clinically normal. No discharge and normal biopsy. Thus safe internally.

### 9. Dr Anderson Cambridge Vet School

Study: Comparison of treatment types for wound management in animals.

Findings: He recommended the use of FLP's Aloe Vera products as the best for wound management.
